

Privacy Policy "Access infection protection law"

1. Person responsible

With this data protection declaration, we inform you about the processing of your personal data by CARIAD SE, Berliner Ring 2, 38440 Wolfsburg, as part of an access to CARIAD SE properties to prevent the spread of Coronavirus Disease-2019 (COVID-19).

2. Collection and processing of personal data

a) General

According to § 28b IfSG, employers and employees may only enter workplaces where physical contact with other persons cannot be excluded if proof of recovery, vaccination or tested status is carried. CARIAD restricts access to the properties for this purpose.

Based on house law, CARIAD is now restricting access to CARIAD properties to all persons for this purpose in order to preclude viral illness of CARIAD employees with Coronavirus Disease-2019 (COVID-19) by visitors.

b) Proof

You can only enter the premises of CARIAD if you can show a valid vaccination certificate, a convalescent certificate or a daily negative corona test in the sense of § 28b (1) IfSG, which is not older than 24 hours.

The vaccination or convalescence status or the daily updated test result will only be processed within the scope of a "visual inspection". No storage will take place.

The processing "visual inspection" without any storage of data takes place in accordance with Art. 9 para. 2 lit. i GDPR in conjunction with § 22 para. 1 No. 1 lit. c BDSG before access to a property of CARIAD SE.

3. Your rights

You have the right to information about the data concerning you, the right to correction of your data, the right to erasure, unless there are any legal regulations to the contrary, as well as a right to object to the processing of your data and the right to restriction of the processing of your data.

If we collect and process your personal data on the basis of your consent, you also have the right to revoke the consent you have given with effect for the future.

Where necessary, we need to verify your identity before we can process your respective request.

If, despite our efforts to ensure data correctness and timeliness, incorrect information is stored, we will correct it after appropriate notice.

We would like to point out that the vaccination or convalescent status or the daily updated test result is only processed by CARIAD within the scope of a "visual inspection" prior to access to a property and no data is stored.
